
WHERE IT STARTED

My name is Shawn Williamson, born December 14, 1985, in Baltimore, Maryland, at John Hopkins hospital to Kevin Rowe and Darlene Williamson. I grew up in North East Baltimore, we moved quite a bit, but we always stay North East between Hartford Rd, Bel Air Rd, and Sinclair Ln. I went to a lot of schools as a result of moving. I went to Gardenville PE pre-K through 2nd, Glenwood third grade, and Furly fourth and fifth grades. Middle school is the only school I stay the whole time from six grade through eighth grade. I went to northeast middle school all three years. I attended northern 9th and at the beginning of the 10th grade first quarter I was expelled. After the expulsion, I went to Lake Clifton night school before I moved to New York, where I attended Freeport high school for a year.

I returned home a year later and went to Lake Clifton for a year before dropping out entirely and going full-time into streetlife selling drugs weed cocaine and eventually heroin.

The previous actions lead me to jail for first-degree assault, charges were dropped due to no one coming to court. I was released home after 11 months in the city jail. I came home with the same mindset and less than a year later went back to prison for attempted murder. Not even a year free this time they had signed statement things were different, but it was A blessing.

I never really read before, being in Baltimore city schools the teachers passed us along and never checked our Homework or anything. I was in special education in elementary school



(DEC)dummy's eating chicken they called us. There were 5 to 10 students per class. Middle and high school they just housed us.

One day the guy in the cell next to me handed me a book riding dirty on I-95. I thought it would be interesting since I used to take trips to New York to cop(buy drugs to sell). So I read it, that book is what got me started reading.

I was released nine months later. After nobody came come to court I was released on stat docket . Once I got back home, I was on the same dumb stuff. I figured I always made money but violence was what got me locked up so I would get back to the basics and I'd be good but as Charlie Murphy said WRONG .

I was wrong, shortly I was arrested for heroin ready rock and Weed I called myself setting up a new strip we got pulled over and no one took the charge. My attorney was able together 4 years for the charge and Boot Camp, a six months program that can be used once for nonviolent offenders. I thought I was okay and would be home in six months, buff and tough. Wrong they lost me in the system and sent me up the farm Hagerstown MCH and never look back.

I fought like hell to get that straight to no avail. I was pissed, but it turned out to be the best thing that ever happened to me because of prison differs from jail.

Jail is housing for prisoners before conviction, prison is housing after your sentence. Prison is more of a community of prisoners. One day in the library, I saw a black guy on a book smoking a cigar with a suit on asking why "Should white guys have all the fun".

I thought that to be a damn good question, so I pick it up and read it. That was the beginning of My journey in personal development. During my time in prison. I lost all of my good days, another blessing, it taught me how to fight with my pen along with teaching me how to program. I took every program 2 to 3 times until there were no more left then began to sign up inmates so much so one time they came to watch me, they thought I was conspiring to do something God knows what. The habit of reading, programming, and helping others carried on into the streets.

While in prison, I noticed there were lots of jobs for drivers 6 to 7 times more than other positions, all with a sign on bonus \$3000 to \$5000 and paid \$50,000 to \$60,000 a year.

Then I met a brother in there who previously owned a truck. He made me aware of the thousands that I could potentially earn weekly. The thought of making that kind of money lifted my vision. The guy I met also had a Truck sales magazine, which made his information valid. I started to fix my credit from the joint. I paid off my driving tickets from the joint and began to study for my CDL permit test from the joint. I also wrote every politician I could to ask for any information on housing, jobs, and cash assistance, they wrote back with loads of information.

I was introduced to that information by someone that was trying to holla at our then mayor. thought he was bluffing until I saw the kite)letter) she sent back, so I took that from his book and used it to my advantage on a whole different scale.

When I got out, I had a valid driver's license and clear credit. I started attending the Allstate career center for my CDL. A month later, I was on the box, home monitoring. I sold snacks at school and worked at Burger King. I also telemarketed for \$18 a day (my first job out at Amvets) and Drove Sedan briefly until someone dropped an eight ball in the car. I returned it then quit. I was finished with the game and the risk was too high to drive Sedan. I also worked as a Flagger on weekends for labor ready. After graduating (from Alstate with my CDL) I work for Midasco LLC doing Constrution and driving dump trucks. I still worked at Burger King until replacing it

with Dominos pizza delivery and still working the temp agency as a Flagger on weekends. I always kept 2-3 jobs. Soon after I got my first real Trucking Job at the port of Baltimore.

I used to hang out at the truckstops and mechanic lots to talk with drivers and owner-operator's. Even at school I would walk next-door and speak to the drivers about rates and learn the business.

The Mechanic at the truck lot put me on with someone who knew someone who gave me a job with someone who had me work for another company express trucking.

By now I'm driving trucks down the port delivering pizza and flagging on the weekends. I soon replaced Dominos with Limo driving. I saw a guy in the parking lot of dominoes with a limo. I asked for a card and called the company. It took a year for my first gig but when It came on New Year's Eve I guit! No more Dominoes for me.

By this time, I have been home for a year I'm working at the Port Driving, Limo's, and flagging on the weekends. I just got my first house brand new everything on Caroline and Preston things were moving so I got my first truck. I got it out of Michigan River City Trucks \$2000 down, drove that for a while then got more. I went from one truck to three in a year.

Soon after I got a DUI, that hurt. I got suspended from work, but while off, I flew to Arizona to take a Freight Broker's course (I am a certified master Freight Broker). I held on as long as I could, but shortly after, I filed bankruptcy and returned the trucks.

I'm now working as a company driver for a Automatic rolls of Baltimore. One of the guys from church (I had no idea that he noticed me) saw me put in an application. He insisted I be hired. You never know who's watching. I worked there for one solid year and rebuilt my credit, still driving limos and Party Busses and flagging.

I also picked up a few more jobs, or should I say eight, I got up to eight jobs literally. I drove a truck for the bakery I had two part-time driving jobs at the port. I was still flagging for the temp agency I drove for Lyft, and Uber worked for a Limo Company and had a Party Bus Job. The final straw was when Allstate hired me as a teacher for their CDL classes, I said its time.

I took a zero money down lease purchase truck and hit the road that truck shortly blew up and back to square one. I came home worked the ports, then got another zero money down lease purchase truck.

I stayed there for a while things were good they paid well I soon got a ticket and was fired. I then received another zero money down lease purchase. A firetruck hit the truck in Atlanta, and my last check of \$2200 got held. Again, and back to square one, I was fed up by this time. I'm now living in Dallas, I got a company driver job there paying \$1350 a week. I did that for two months straight, saved everything, and went independent.

Independent is the way to go. It gives you the ability to have authority and book your own Loads ,that was going well. I was making good money saved close to \$25,000 in 3 months then started to add drivers. My business increased. I went from 0 to 7 trucks in less than a year. A year Big mistake I grew before I knew.

Drivers are in high demand in this industry. Soon i realized I'd better off driving solo, I quickly figured I'd be better off driving solo because it's less money and more profit. I now spend my time traveling, making thousands per week meeting interesting people attending cool events trying different foods, shopping all over the country, and enjoying being free.

There are thousands of trucks and drivers needed. 'There's a high demand for drivers due to the Driver Shortage in America, according to the Washington Post." We

need 51,000 drivers by the end of this year, and there are already 3.5 million CDL holders in the United States.

Another thing that makes trucking an excellent opportunity is the training requirements. You can get a class a CDL in as little as one month. I received mine in 6

months from Allstate Career center. There are ways to get CDL training free and to be hired immediately by the company with no up front capital; this is an excellent way to start from ground zero.

What's the income for Truckers?

There are three ways to make money as a driver:

Company driver



2. Owner-operator and

3.

Having your operating authority

A company driver is one who works for the company and has no vested interest in the truck or the company.

According to "CNN the median wage for a truck driver is

\$73,000. From my own experience I have known drivers to make \$50,000 to \$70,000 a year. \$900 to \$1200 per week can be expecting \$1500 in the summer when the shipper's freight is in season.

One can graduate from company driver to owner-operators. They own or lease their trucks, pay for fuel cost, maintenance, and tolls depending on the agreement. But you have no interest in the company, the gross, on average \$183.000 per year cording to

Indeed.com from my experience they usually make \$125,000 to \$150,000 per year. weekly take-home could gross \$2500 to \$3000 per week \$3500 peak season. "Don't get too comfortable here there's another level".

Operating Authority is the final level concerning driving. When you have your authority, it is just that authority. You own or lease the truck, own the company you

book your Loads and set your freight rates. According to what the market can bear. Heres where you make the \$250,000 per year possibly \$300,000 or \$500,000 (if you run teams) my first year I did \$245,981 from February to December my first 12 months my truck


did \$277,000 you should do between \$23,000 and \$28,000 a month or \$5000 to \$7000 per week on average.

What's fun about trucking?

- 2. Food
- 3. Family

As an independent driver, you get paid to travel. Try different foods and visit family and friends all over the country.

Drivers get paid thousands to travel for



free. I've visited every state in the union, all the major cities, and have stopped to had fun. I have been everywhere from Miami to New York, Seattle to LA, Houston to Chicago, Atlanta to Oakland, and All the cities between those. It's been fun I did it all from Jet Skies, parasailing, bungee jumping, hot air balloons, race cars, roller coasters, zoos, aquariums, tours, concerts, and conferences. You name it all while being paid. As a independent you book your loads and determine your routes.

Schedule your time appropriately, so you arrive on Friday. Book a room, get a car, set up some tours, meet a few locals, and there you go.

You also get to try all types of food in each state, city, and region, which has food native to the area and culture. I've tried things like the barbecued eel, Pig

brain, frog legs, octopus, Squid, and crawfish, etc. I've had some of the best barbecues in the south, and the freshest seafood from Seattle they caught the oysters right out front, and of course, Baltimore makes the best crabs it's been a journey of sightseeing

and excellent restaurants.

You also get to visit family and friends and meet stars all over. I stopped to see all of my family on both sides. Some I haven't seen in ages some, I have never

met. I've also made friends all over the country and built relationships. I still nurture o this day.

It's been a ride along with seeing family and meeting friends. You also bump into stars everywhere just being in the right place at the right time. J prince, master

P, and Stevie j were probably the three most famous people I've met while traveling, it's been a journey.

What's the point of this all. Trucking is a way you can make thousands of dollars legally, travel free and live an amazing life without breaking law regardless if

you have a criminal record or no college degree!!!

The value in this book is not the literature itself but the documented proof of potential income and access to me.



- 1. Step 1) Get an ID; A state ID is it the basic form of identification for persons over eighteen and a must-have for people fresh out of jail/prison
- Step 2) Get your driver's license; I order to get a class a CDL you must start with a regular class C drivers
 license each state varies in the process to obtain
- 3. Step 3) Get your class A CDL; each state is different, but typically the process is between zero and ten thousand dollars and between one to six months of training you can get A CDL free by going with a major company they will pay for your travel and hotel you will be required to work for them after completion however you could also use local teachers and small schools that charge a fee as well
- 4.

 Step 4) Get six months driving experience; there are things in trucking that one can only learn through trial and error these errors cost don't jump out there buy a truck and tear it up costing yourself thousands or possibly put yourself out of business learn to drive on major companies dime they can absorb the cost with less damage to their financial status
- Step 5) Become an owner-operator; most major companies have zero money down lease purchase walk away trucks.

Which means you invest no money and can leave at any time after returning the truck with no credit penalties. It is great because, with zero investment, you can start making \$2500 to \$3000 a week, allowing you to save \$200 to \$500 a week a faster way to get

your truck and operating authority. It also provides experience with maintaining the business side, such as freight rates, fuel cost, maintenance, etc. Do this for a year and save \$200 to \$500 per week

 and a Duns number to start building business credit you are now officially a business register your company with

It separates you from the owner-operator, you are in total control you book your own loads set freight rates and handle all paperwork. It's he difference between \$2500 to \$3000 a week or \$5000 to \$7000 a week

Step 8) Get access to a Load Board; you need an MC or DOT number to get on to a Load Board this is where Broker's

post Loads to be hauled you want to get access early so you can start getting familiar with freight rates do this even before getting a truck so you can get a feel for the flow of things and have a realistic expectation of the money to be made

Step 9) Find a truck you like; figure out your cost. Find a truck you like, fill out an application for financing, or look within your cash budget. Now you have a realistic approach of the cost, take down the year make and model and mileage of your truck you'll need this to get insurance quotes insurance is what stops most people from moving forward you can lease or rent

a truck if you don't have the cash to buy one but with insurance There are no shortcuts it cost \$3000 to \$5000 down to insure your company, and your authority is not active until you have insurance, do this before you purchase or lease use mock truck if necessary

Step 10) Get truck number one; there's many ways to get a truck you'll need \$1500 to \$7000 to start you can lease

a truck that's a low start-up cost its good because they'll pay for repairs saving you money and you can write off 100% of a leased truck on your taxes depending on the structure of your company and state (I'm not a lawyer or an account) it saves money all

around the board also you may be able to purchase at a later date you can also buy a truck this cost between 20% and 30% down if you finance a truck I suggest getting a truck under five years old with less than 500,000 miles with original manufacturers warranty

this will stop you from getting knocked out of the game by a major repair trust me happens, or I would suggest getting a truck order that 2007 with no DEF these trucks are good DEF has taken lots of people out of the game those repairs cost, you can get a


decent truck with \$10,000 to \$15,000 and own it free and clear

- Step 11) Get the truck inspected; once you have a truck Unless it's leased or rented even though It may have been sold to you DOT inspected you'll still need your state-specific inspection to get tags this cost \$300 to \$400 depending on the number of axles
- Step 12) get tags; Unless the truck is rented or leased you'll need tags to start running the truck this cost around \$1600 to \$2000 depending on how many states you add I suggest adding all 48 states, so you're not limited in your travels if a big load comes up
- Step 13) Activate insurance; now that you got the truck and tags you need insurance to pull loads some places you'll need insurance before picking up the truck at least bobtail insurance now you're set to start pulling loads

 Step 14) Work local 21 days; once you're tagged and inspected you can book loads you're only allowed to run within



your state the first 21 business days waiting for your MC and dot numbers to clear the system, this is good because it allows you to get familiar with booking Loads talking to Broker's and filling out paperwork it's a lot to do while driving in the beginning

Step 15) Make \$250,000 a year; once your MC and DOT numbers clear hit the road running my first big load was

\$6000 from Pennsylvania to Washington state, and I needed every penny I booked that load got a cash advance for 40% of the load Put some money in my pocket to make it through the week and The rest is history my truck does between \$23,000 and \$27,000 per month

every month my first 12 months I did \$277,000. In my first Calendar year, I made \$245,981 in 10 months.

Advice:


- Save \$10,000 cash or credit per truck, and you'll never go out of business.
- Five trucks gross one million with your Owner Authority.
- Five trucks are needed to replace you as a driver.
